Written testimonial of my experience at the 2015 conference for Ricardo Salinas scholarship

My experience at ANDE Conference this year was great because I could learn from peers, share our experience at NESsT with other intermediaries like us, strengthen my global network and meet individually more than 20 people through pre-scheduled meetings. The key learning topics were: the barriers and challenges of the Funds for Impact enterprises in Latin America reinforcing the existence of the missing middle; the challenges regarding attracting and developing talent for impact enterprises; the challenge of raising money for intermediaries; the power of good policies but also the challenges on how to address the governments in emerging market countries; the logic and the benefits behind the platform that gives loans for early stage enterprises and how strong is to raise money from the crowd; exits in impact investing and existing data to bring impact investing to the main stream. The main takeaways were: how to balance global and local knowledge and partnerships; how to work in collaboration with peers; how to address the missing middle.

The Conference impacts us by opening doors and provoking us to leave our comfortable zone sharing both our successes and our failures. The sessions are very interactive and give everybody an opportunity to learn and share. It brings a great balance between lectures, networking spaces and round tables.
